# **2024 Emissions Requirements**

### Davis, Salt Lake, Utah & Weber Counties

Vehicles with model years less than six years old are required to have an emission test once every two years. Vehicles in this category with even-numbered model years must have an emission test in even-numbered years, and vehicles that have odd-numbered model years must have an emission test in odd-numbered years.

## **Cache County**

Vehicles registered in Cache County with model years **less than six years old** are not required to have an emission test. Vehicles **six years old and greater** that have even-numbered model years must have an emission test in even-numbered years, and vehicles that have odd-numbered model years must have an emission test in odd-numbered years.

### **Exemptions by County**

#### **Cache County**

- New Implement of husbandry
- Farm truck
- Any vehicle used for maintenance or construction and not designed or licensed to operate on the highway
- Any motorcycle or motor driven cycle
- Electric vehicles
- Vintage Vehicles model year 1983 & older or custom vehicles
- Off highway vehicles
- Any diesel vehicle 1997 and older
- Any diesel vehicle with a GVWR greater than 14,000 lbs.
- Any gasoline (and non-diesel based alternative fuel) vehicles 2008 and newer model year with a GVWR greater than 14,000 lbs.
- Any gasoline (and non-diesel based alternative fuel) vehicles 2007 and older with a GVWR greater than 8,500 lbs.
- Vehicles with an MSO

#### **Davis County**

- New Vehicles with an MSO
- Any non-diesel-powered vehicle model year 1967 & older
- Any vehicle used for maintenance or construction & not designed or licensed to operate on the highway
- Any motorcycle or motor driven cycle
- Off highway vehicles
- Electric Vehicles
- Any vintage or custom vehicles
- Heavy duty diesel vehicles that meet all the following:
  - Have an apportioned registration
  - $\circ \quad \text{Have a GVWR of 26,000 lbs. or greater} \\$
  - $\circ\quad$  Miles logged outside of Utah are 50% or more
  - $\circ \quad \text{Are within the first three model years} \\$

#### **Salt Lake County**

- New vehicles with an MSO
- Any vehicle w/ model year 1967 & older
- Any diesel vehicle w/ model year 2013 and older with a GVWR 14,001 and over
- Any diesel vehicle w/ model year 1997 & older with a GVWR less than 14,000 lbs
- All implements of husbandry
- Off highway vehicles
- Electric vehicles
- Motorcycles or motor driven cycles
- Farm vehicles
- Vintage Vehicles model year 1982 & older or custom vehicles
- Maintenance or construction vehicles not
- Designed or licensed to operate on a highway

#### **Utah County**

- New vehicles with an MSO
- Any vehicle 1967 & older
- Implement of husbandry (Farm) vehicles
- · Any vehicle used for maintenance or construction and not designed or licensed to operate on the highway
- Any motorcycle or motor driven cycle
- Electric vehicles
- Any motor vehicle which is powered by an engine that is 650cc or less
- Any motor vehicle which is powered by a 2-cycle engine
- Vintage Vehicles model year 1982 and older or Custom vehicles
- Off highway vehicles
- Diesel powered vehicles 1997 & older
- Diesel vehicles with GVWR greater than 14,000 lbs
- Diesel vehicle 2020 and newer

### **Commercial Vehicles**

**Safety Inspection:** All Commercial Vehicles require an annual safety inspection.

Safety Inspections are not a pre-requisite for registration. However, the certificates are required to be always kept in the vehicle.

<u>Emissions:</u> Vehicles with model years less than six years old need an emissions inspection once every two years. Vehicles in this category that have even-numbered model years must have emissions inspections in even-numbered years, and vehicles that have odd-numbered model years must have emissions inspections in odd-numbered years. Vehicles six years old & older require emissions every year. Emissions for gas powered vehicles are due in Cache, Davis, Salt Lake, Utah, and Weber counties.

#### **Emissions Exemptions by County**

- **Weber-** Vehicles less than two years old, electric vehicles, OHVs, IOHs, vehicles 1967 & older, motorcycles, vintage vehicles, custom vehicles, diesel vehicles 1997 & older, diesel vehicles with a GVWR greater than 14,000 lbs.
- ➤ **Davis- Davis-** Vehicles less than two years old, electric vehicles, OHVs, IOHs, vehicles 1967 & older, motorcycles, vintage vehicles, custom vehicles, heavyduty diesel vehicles with an IRP registration and GVWR 26,000 lbs. or more and have logged more than 50% of miles outside of Utah and are within the first three (3) model years
- > **Salt Lake-** Vehicles less than two years old, electric vehicles, OHVs, IOHs, vehicles 1967 & older, motorcycles, vintage vehicles, custom vehicles, diesel vehicles 1997 & older with a GVWR 14,000 lbs. or less
- ▶ **Utah-** Vehicles less than two years old, electric vehicles, OHVs, IOHs, motorcycles, vehicles 1967 & older, vintage vehicles, custom vehicles, diesel vehicles 1997 & older, diesel vehicles five years old and newer, diesel vehicles with a GVWR greater than 14,000 lbs.
- **Cache County Exemptions-** Vehicles less than six years old, electric vehicles, OHVs, IOHs, vehicles 1968 & older, motorcycles, vintage vehicles, custom vehicles, diesel vehicles 1997 & older, diesel vehicles with a GVWR greater than 14,000 lbs.
